**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1381 requires students who attend a private school and for whom a taxpayer has successfully claimed a tax credit pursuant to the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit Act to be administered the statewide student assessments required of public school students beginning in the 2024-25 school year. SDE's assumption is that private school students comprise approximately 8.5% of our testing population, or 29,500 students.
