Fiscal Analysis

SB 1437 would create a felony for any person convicted of committing battery against a school employee while such employee is in the performance of any duties as a school employee. Any person found guilty shall be subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 2 years and/or a fine of up to \$3,000.00. The FY'23 incremental/average cost to incarcerate an inmate was \$6,811.85 annually or \$18.66 per day.
