Fiscal Analysis

SB 1453 would expand approved purposes as it relates to the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants Act to include any approved uses as authorized by opioid-related settlement agreements made by the state. The measure authorizes the Attorney General to withhold not more than 5% of the funds received by the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Revolving Fund for staff and administrative support. The Office of the Attorney General does not anticipate this to have a fiscal impact.
