Fiscal Analysis

SB 1641 would allow individuals aggrieved by a decision of the Department of Human Services relating to placement on the Restricted Registry to appeal to the district court of the county in which the childcare facility is maintained. If an individual successfully appeals the placement, the Department shall remove the individual from the Registry. Additionally, the court is directed to award appropriate relief to the prevailing individual. The measure authorizes aggrieved individuals to bring actions against the Department alleging violations of state law pertaining to the process of recording an individual on the Restricted Registry. The Department of Human Services anticipates at least one additional FTE required at a cost of \$150,000 per fiscal year.
