**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1662 requires the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) to develop procedures in accordance with the federal National Child Protection Act of 1993 and the federal Volunteers for Children Act to enable a qualified entity to request a state and national criminal history record check to determine whether a covered individual is the subject of any child abuse crime. OSBI does not anticipate any fiscal impact if the measure is implemented. Though, the agency states there is a potential for lost future revenue if it is not implemented.
