Fiscal Analysis

SB 236 establishes a grant program to provide school districts and charter schools with grants to purchase AED for a school site, purchase parts and maintenance for the AED and provide training to school employees to use AED and CPR.

Per unit estimated cost of AED device package - \$1500-\$2500.

Estimated replacement parts: pads per unit - \$30-\$400; batteries per unit - \$175-\$600.

Estimated CPR training cost - \$5-\$120 per person.

Maintenance costs will vary and are hard to determine. Estimated overall cost to supply every school building with an AED only - \$4,500,000. Pads only - \$725,000. Batteries only - \$1,080,000. Training only - \$216,000
