10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
12 Commerce; requiring that portions of certain funds be
13 utilized for certain purposes; providing budgeting
14 and expenditure limitations and procedures; providing
for lapse of funds under certain conditions;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
19 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
20 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Hundred
21 Twenty-nine Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$229,945.00)
22 shall, under the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be
23 allocated to support the Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance
24 Program.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
2 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
3 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
4 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under the direction of
5 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to various Councils
6 of Government to support substate planning.

7 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
8 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
9 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Thirty-six
10 Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-one Dollars (\$36,221.00) shall, under
11 the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
12 support the functions of community action agencies.

13 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
14 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
15 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
16 Eighty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-four Dollars
17 (\$183,874.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
18 of Commerce, be allocated to community action agencies to support
19 Head Start programs.

20 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
21 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
22 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Sixty-four
23 Thousand Two Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$64,217.00) shall, under the
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1 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the
2 RX for Oklahoma Prescription Assistance program.

3 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
5 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Eight Hundred
6 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) shall, under the direction of
7 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to support Small
8 Business Development Centers.

9 SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
10 Department of Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd
11 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ten Million
12 Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive
13 Director of Commerce, be allocated to help fund at Rogers State
14 University a new Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics
15 (STEM) building.

16 SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25) or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 (hereafter FY-26).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2025, and must be expended by November 15, 2025. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2025, and not budgeted for FY-26, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-26 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2026. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2026, shall lapse
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-25, and not required to pay
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-26, after
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
8 from the FY-25 budget work program and after such revision has been
9 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

10 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

11 SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
