7 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
8 authorizing creation and administration of certain
9 pilot program; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-140a of Title 47, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The Department of Public Safety shall establish and
16 administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced
17 Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The purpose
18 of this program is to increase the number of peace officers
19 qualified to conduct certain drug-impairment screening tests during
20 impaired driving investigations.

21 B. The Department is authorized to provide funding, administer
22 the program, and establish grant criteria regarding the
23 administration of the program.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
