10 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
11 Section 11-107.1, which relates to academic courses
12 for certain high school students; requiring school
13 districts to provide academic support for students
14 who score below certain benchmarks on the ACT or SAT
15 exam; allowing certain types of academic support;
16 prohibiting the exclusion of students from certain
17 activities and coursework; authorizing State Board of
18 Education to promulgate rules; and providing an
19 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 11-107.1, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 11-107.1 A. ~~Each~~ Beginning with the 2028-2029 school
24 year, any school district in this state may offer a remediation
course shall provide academic support for high school ~~students~~
juniors and seniors who score below a ~~nineteen (19) on the~~

1 benchmarks on subject-area portions of the American College Testing
2 (ACT) exam or below an equivalent score scores on the SAT Scholastic
3 Aptitude Test (SAT) exam in the most recent year for which student
4 performance data is available.

5 B. Academic support required by subsection A of this section
6 may include but is not limited to:

7 1. Extended instructional time during the school day;

8 2. A summer academy;

9 3. Tutoring;

10 4. Online coursework;

11 5. Repetition of any course in which the student has

12 demonstrated academic deficiency by scoring below the benchmarks in

13 subject-area portions of the ACT or below equivalent scores on the

14 SAT;

15 6. Any course designed to address areas of deficiency; or

16 7. Any other means of academic support.

17 C. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed

18 to require that a teacher providing ~~instruction in the remediation~~

19 ~~course~~ academic support be certified in any subject matter that is

20 tested on the ACT or SAT exam.

21 D. Students receiving academic support as required by

22 subsection A of this section shall not be excluded from

23 participating in extracurricular activities or enrolling in

24 technology center school district courses or programs.

1 E. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to
2 implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
