

10 [ medical marijuana - promulgation of rules - potency  
11 limits - codification - effective date ]

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.18a of Title 63, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana  
18 Authority shall promulgate rules to limit the tetrahydrocannabinol  
19 (THC) serving size of edible medical marijuana products sold in  
20 medical marijuana dispensaries. The serving sizes imposed by such  
21 rules shall be at the discretion of the Executive Director;  
22 provided, that the limits do not exceed:

1           1. One thousand milligrams (1,000 mg) delta-9  
2 tetrahydrocannabinol per package for edible medical marijuana  
3 products;

4           2. Five milligrams (5 mg) of delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol or  
5 any other tetrahydrocannabinol isomer or analogue that occurs  
6 naturally in cannabis per package for edible medical marijuana  
7 products; and

8           3. An action level of 1.0 parts per million (0.0001%) of any  
9 tetrahydrocannabinol isomer, tetrahydrocannabinol analogue, or any  
10 other cannabinoid that does not occur naturally in cannabis per  
11 package for edible medical marijuana products. A list of such  
12 compounds may be established at the discretion of the Executive  
13 Director.

14           B. A licensed medical marijuana dispensary shall not sell any  
15 edible medical marijuana product that exceeds the THC per package  
16 limits imposed in this section.

17           C. For medical marijuana patients eighteen (18) years of age or  
18 younger, the Executive Director may impose further limits on THC per  
19 serving in edible medical marijuana products. No dispensaries shall  
20 be allowed to sell any medical marijuana product for the use of  
21 vaping to any medical marijuana patient eighteen (18) years of age  
22 or younger.

23           D. The Executive Director shall establish rules that require  
24 dispensaries to provide educational efforts to patients regarding

1 potency, dosing, and pharmacological impacts pertaining to usage and  
2 consumption of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2025.
