9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2021,
11 Section 21-101, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 291,
12 O.S.L. 2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 21-101),
13 which relates to integrated system of election
14 administration; requiring certain voting system to
15 utilize technology to allow tracking of ballot; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 21-101, as
19 amended by Section 5, Chapter 291, O.S.L. 2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022,
20 Section 21-101), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 21-101. A. The Secretary of the State Election Board
22 is hereby authorized beginning July 1, 1989, to purchase equipment
23 for and implement a unitary, unified, integrated system of election
24 administration for the State of Oklahoma that includes an electronic
data processing system for maintenance of voter registration

1 records, certification of election results and other election-
2 related applications, and the installation of electronic, optical
3 scanning voting devices compatible with the same system in every
4 precinct polling place.

5 B. The Secretary of the State Election Board is authorized to
6 adopt procedures consistent, insofar as practicable, with existing
7 law for implementation of the system.

8 C. Except as provided in subsection A of this section, no
9 electronic data processing applications shall be implemented by a
10 county election board, nor shall voting devices be purchased by a
11 county, except for those electronic data processing applications and
12 voting devices already in use or for which a contract had been
13 signed by no later than March 31, 1986.

14 D. A new unitary integrated voting system described in
15 subsection A of this section that is implemented on or after January
16 1, 2023, shall be required to report the official election returns
17 of each election by precinct, including, but not limited to, all
18 votes cast in person and by absentee ballot.

19 E. A new unitary integrated voting system described in
20 subsection A of this section that is implemented on or after January
21 1, 2024, shall utilize technology that would provide the voter a
22 unique identifier to allow the voter to track his or her paper
23 ballot online to confirm that the ballot was counted and correctly
24 recorded his or her votes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2024.
