





9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
11 to refer to the people for their approval or  
12 rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma  
13 Constitution by adding a new Section 9E to Article X;  
14 allowing for the creation of public infrastructure  
15 districts; requiring certain conditions for the  
16 creation of a public infrastructure district;  
17 allowing municipalities to limit powers of the public  
18 infrastructure districts; authorizing additional  
19 levies to be imposed for certain purpose; authorizing  
20 the Legislature to enact laws necessary for the  
21 implementation of public infrastructure districts;  
22 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

23  
24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by  
adding a new Section 9E to Article X to read as follows:

1 Section 9E. A. There are hereby created public infrastructure  
2 districts.

3 B. Municipalities may approve the creation of public  
4 infrastructure districts, which may incur indebtedness and issue  
5 public infrastructure district bonds to pay for all or part of the  
6 cost of public improvements within such districts. The cost of all  
7 indebtedness so incurred shall be levied and assessed by the board  
8 of trustees of a public infrastructure district on the property  
9 benefited by such improvements following the passage and approval of  
10 the organization of a public infrastructure district pursuant to  
11 subsection C of this section. The board shall collect the special  
12 assessments so levied and use the same to reimburse the public  
13 infrastructure district for the amount paid or to be paid by it on  
14 the bonds issued for such improvements not to exceed ten (10) mills  
15 for the purpose of providing funds for the purpose of support,  
16 organization, operation, and maintenance of such services.

17 C. A public infrastructure district shall not be created unless  
18 a petition is filed with the municipality that contains the  
19 signatures of one hundred percent (100%) of surface property owners  
20 within the applicable area consenting to the creation of the public  
21 infrastructure district.

22 D. The municipality may impose limitations on the powers of the  
23 public infrastructure district through the governing document  
24 presented by the public infrastructure district applicant.

1 E. The levy shall be in addition to all other levies authorized  
2 by this Constitution, and when approved, shall be made for the  
3 repayment of public infrastructure district bonds issued by the  
4 public infrastructure districts for the public improvements agreed  
5 upon by the voters of the district as provided by the governing  
6 document.

7 F. The Legislature shall be authorized to enact such laws as  
8 may be necessary in order to implement public infrastructure  
9 districts in this state.

10 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
11 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
12 the following form:

15 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

16 This measure adds a new section of law to the Oklahoma  
17 Constitution. It adds Section 9E to Article 10. It allows for  
18 the creation of public infrastructure districts. It provides  
19 for the issuance of public infrastructure district bonds by the  
20 public infrastructure district to pay for all or part of all  
21 public improvements implemented by and for the public  
22 infrastructure district. It requires a one-hundred-percent  
23 approval of surface property owners in the district to become  
24 created.
