10 An Act relating to driver licenses; creating the
11 Lowering Insurance and Benefitting the Economy,
12 Roads, Taxpayers, and Yourself (LIBERTY) Act;
13 amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1550.42, which relates
14 to entities authorized to print identification
15 documents; clarifying language; removing certain
16 limitation; removing certain exceptions; removing
17 certain license renewal requirement; removing certain
18 presumption; removing certain application; removing
19 certain exemption; amending 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-
20 109.3, as amended by Section 15, Chapter 282, O.S.L.
21 2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 4-109.3), which
22 relates to motor vehicle licensing agencies and voter
23 registration; prohibiting voter registration services
24 from being provided to certain applicants and
 licensees; requiring Service Oklahoma transmit
 certain identifying information to the Secretary of
 the State Election Board; requiring certain action
 and notice; prohibiting retention of certain
 information; providing certain exception; amending 47
 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as amended by Section 37,
 Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
 6-101), which relates to class requirements for
 driver licenses and fees; creating certain fees;
 directing certain deposit; amending 47 O.S. 2021,
 Section 6-103, as amended by Section 40, Chapter 282,
 O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 6-103),
 which relates to persons not to be licensed; updating
 statutory references; modifying preclusion; requiring

1 certain documents be presented to allow for the
2 issuance of driver licenses to aliens; amending 47
3 O.S. 2021, Section 6-106, as amended by Section 45,
4 Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
5 6-106), which relates to application for license;
6 providing an acceptable form of proof of identity;
7 allowing for certain information to be provided by an
8 applicant; updating statutory reference; providing
9 certain preclusions; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section
10 6-114, as amended by Section 54, Chapter 282, O.S.L.
11 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 6-114), which
12 relates to replacement driver licenses; removing
13 certain requirements and replacement period
14 limitations for aliens; amending 47 O.S. 2021,
15 Section 6-115, as amended by Section 55, Chapter 282,
16 O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 6-115),
17 which relates to issuance, expiration, and renewal of
18 driver licenses; modifying certain limitations for
19 certain applicants or licensees; requiring certain
20 applicants provide additional specific documentation;
21 amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-122, as amended by
22 Section 62, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp.
23 2022, Section 6-122), which relates to renewal by
24 mail; modifying certain exceptions; requiring Service
Oklahoma to provide certain notation of status;
prohibiting voter registration services from being
provided to certain applicants and licensees;
providing for noncodification; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Lowering
Insurance and Benefitting the Economy, Roads, Taxpayers, and
Yourself (LIBERTY) Act".

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1550.42, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1550.42. ~~A.~~ The following entities may create, publish
4 or otherwise manufacture an identification document, identification
5 card, or identification certificate and may possess an engraved
6 plate or other such device for the printing of such identification;
7 provided, the name of the issuing entity shall be clearly printed
8 upon the face of the identification:

9 1. Businesses, companies, corporations, service organizations
10 and federal, state and local governmental agencies for employee
11 identification which is designed to identify the bearer as an
12 employee;

13 2. Businesses, companies, corporations and service
14 organizations for customer identification which is designed to
15 identify the bearer as a customer or member;

16 3. Federal, state and local government agencies for purposes
17 authorized or required by law or any legitimate purpose consistent
18 with the duties of such an agency, including, but not limited to,
19 voter identification cards, driver licenses, nondriver
20 identification cards, passports, birth certificates and ~~social~~
21 ~~security~~ Social Security cards;

22 4. Any public school or state or private educational
23 institution, as defined by Sections 1-106, 21-101 or 3102 of Title
24

1 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to identify the bearer as an
2 administrator, faculty member, student or employee;

3 5. Any professional organization or labor union to identify the
4 bearer as a member of the professional organization or labor union;
5 and

6 6. Businesses, companies or corporations which manufacture
7 medical-alert identification for the wearer thereof.

8 ~~B. All identification documents as provided for in paragraph 3
9 or 4 of subsection A of this section shall be issued only to United
10 States citizens, nationals and legal permanent resident aliens.~~

11 ~~C. The provisions of subsection B of this section shall not
12 apply when an applicant presents, in person, valid documentary
13 evidence of:~~

14 ~~1. A valid, unexpired immigrant or nonimmigrant visa status for
15 admission into the United States;~~

16 ~~2. A pending or approved application for asylum in the United
17 States;~~

18 ~~3. Admission into the United States in refugee status;~~

19 ~~4. A pending or approved application for temporary protected
20 status in the United States;~~

21 ~~5. Approved deferred action status; or~~

22 ~~6. A pending application for adjustment of status to legal
23 permanent residence status or conditional resident status.~~

24

1 ~~Upon approval, the applicant may be issued an identification~~
2 ~~document provided for in paragraph 3 or 4 of subsection A of this~~
3 ~~section. Such identification document shall be valid only during~~
4 ~~the period of time of the authorized stay of the applicant in the~~
5 ~~United States or, if there is no definite end to the period of~~
6 ~~authorized stay, a period of one (1) year. Any identification~~
7 ~~document issued pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall~~
8 ~~clearly indicate that it is temporary and shall state the date that~~
9 ~~the identification document expires. Such identification document~~
10 ~~may be renewed only upon presentation of valid documentary evidence~~
11 ~~that the status by which the applicant qualified for the~~
12 ~~identification document has been extended by the United States~~
13 ~~Citizenship and Immigration Services or other authorized agency of~~
14 ~~the United States Department of Homeland Security.~~

15 ~~D. The provisions of subsection B of this section shall not~~
16 ~~apply to an identification document described in paragraph 4 of~~
17 ~~subsection A of this section that is only valid for use on the~~
18 ~~campus or facility of that educational institution and includes a~~
19 ~~statement of such restricted validity clearly and conspicuously~~
20 ~~printed upon the face of the identification document.~~

21 ~~E. Any driver license issued to a person who is not a United~~
22 ~~States citizen, national or legal permanent resident alien for which~~
23 ~~an application has been made for renewal, duplication or reissuance~~
24 ~~shall be presumed to have been issued in accordance with the~~

1 ~~provisions of subsection C of this section; provided that, at the~~
2 ~~time the application is made, the driver license has not expired, or~~
3 ~~been cancelled, suspended or revoked. The requirements of~~
4 ~~subsection C of this section shall apply, however, to a renewal,~~
5 ~~duplication or reissuance if the Department of Public Safety is~~
6 ~~notified by a local, state or federal government agency of~~
7 ~~information in the possession of the agency indicating a reasonable~~
8 ~~suspicion that the individual seeking such renewal, duplication or~~
9 ~~reissuance is present in the United States in violation of law. The~~
10 ~~provisions of this subsection shall not apply to United States~~
11 ~~citizens, nationals or legal permanent resident aliens.~~

12 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-109.3, as
13 amended by Section 15, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022,
14 Section 4-109.3), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4-109.3 A. When a qualified elector applies for
16 issuance or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license, or issuance of a
17 state identification card issued pursuant to Section 6-105 of Title
18 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, he or she shall be provided voter
19 registration services as required by the National Voter Registration
20 Act. Any applicant or licensee providing an individual tax
21 identification number to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator
22 pursuant to Section 6-106 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall
23 not be provided voter registration services. All completed paper
24 voter registration applications shall be transmitted by the agency

1 accepting the application at the close of business each week to the
2 State Election Board in preaddressed, postage prepaid envelopes
3 provided by the State Election Board. If a person registers or
4 declines to register to vote, the office at which the person submits
5 the voter registration application or the fact that the person
6 declined to register shall remain confidential and will be used only
7 for voter registration purposes.

8 B. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or state
9 identification card submitted by a registered voter shall also serve
10 as a change of address for voter registration purposes if the new
11 address is within the same county where the voter is registered to
12 vote. If the new address is outside the county where the voter is
13 currently registered to vote, the voter shall be sent a notice and
14 application with instructions for registering to vote at the new
15 address. A change of address for an Oklahoma driver license or
16 state identification card shall not be used to update a voter
17 registration address if the registrant states in writing that the
18 change of address is not for voter registration purposes.

19 C. Licensed operators shall receive fifty cents (\$0.50) per
20 valid paper voter registration application or application for change
21 in voter registration taken by themselves and employees of the
22 licensed operator's office taken at the licensed operator's office,
23 payable by the State Election Board.

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1 D. Service Oklahoma shall notify the Secretary of the State
2 Election Board of licensed operator appointments. Service Oklahoma
3 shall notify the Secretary of the State Election Board of licensed
4 operators qualified to issue driver licenses.

5 E. The Secretary of the State Election Board is authorized to
6 develop with Service Oklahoma a system to electronically transmit
7 voter registration applications from licensed operators to the State
8 Election Board or county election boards. Such system shall be
9 consistent with the requirements for electronic submission of voter
10 registration applications provided in Section 4-109.4 of this title.

11 F. 1. At least quarterly, Service Oklahoma shall transmit to
12 the Secretary of the State Election Board identifying information
13 that shall include the name, date of birth, residential address, and
14 mailing address, of all applicants or licensees who have provided an
15 individual tax identification number pursuant to Section 6-106 of
16 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

17 2. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall compare the
18 transmitted identifying information provided pursuant to paragraph 1
19 of this subsection with the list of registered voters in each
20 county. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall notify the
21 secretary of any relevant county election board of any matches based
22 on the identifying information provided by Service Oklahoma.

23 3. Upon receipt of notification from the Secretary of the State
24 Election Board pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection, the

1 secretary of the county election board shall notify the proper
2 authority pursuant to Section 16-123 of this title, to investigate
3 whether a violation related to voting crimes or voter registration
4 has occurred.

5 4. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall not retain
6 the information provided pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection
7 after the completion of his or her duties pursuant to paragraph 2 of
8 this subsection except as may be necessary when assisting with an
9 investigation.

10 G. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate
11 rules and procedures to implement the requirements of this section.

12 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as
13 amended by Section 37, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
14 Section 6-101), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter
16 expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title,
17 shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless
18 the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of
19 vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No
20 person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at
21 any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this
22 section.

23 B. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor
24 vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and

1 holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in
2 paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section.
3 Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be
4 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C and D, except
5 as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

6 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle
7 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a
8 valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph 5
9 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class B
10 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in
11 Classes B, C and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this
12 subsection.

13 3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle
14 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a
15 valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F
16 of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C commercial
17 license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C
18 and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

19 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be
20 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be
21 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,
22 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;
23 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be
24 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded

1 for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F,
2 except as provided in subsection F of this section.

3 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who
4 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be
5 issued by Service Oklahoma:

6 a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall
7 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
8 A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest
9 purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or

10 b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall
11 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
12 B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a
13 Class D motor vehicle.

14 6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
15 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class
16 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this
17 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
18 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

19 C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section
20 may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and
21 highways in this state.

22 D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle
23 without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle
24 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant

1 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully
2 complete a written examination, vision examination and driving
3 examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of
4 Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, and a certified
5 state-approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the
6 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, if the applicant
7 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a
8 motorcycle endorsement thereon. The written examination and driving
9 examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service Oklahoma
10 upon verification that the person has successfully completed a
11 certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course approved by the
12 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

13 E. Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully
14 possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for
15 renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written
16 examination, vision examination and driving examination for a
17 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with
18 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic
19 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service
20 Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to
21 be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination
22 and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service
23 Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully

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1 completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course
2 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

3 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply
4 for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit. Service
5 Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the
6 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all
7 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license
8 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a
9 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having
10 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a
11 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant
12 to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or C
13 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the
14 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules
15 promulgated by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

16 2. This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period
17 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one hundred eighty
18 (180) days, which may be renewed one time for an additional one
19 hundred eighty (180) days; provided, such commercial learner permit
20 may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied or disqualified at the
21 discretion of the Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for
22 violation of the restrictions, for failing to give the required or
23 correct information on the application or for violation of any
24 traffic laws of this state pertaining to the operation of a motor

1 vehicle. Except as otherwise provided, the lawful possessor of a
2 commercial learner permit who has been issued a commercial learner
3 permit for a minimum of fourteen (14) days may have the restriction
4 requiring an accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily
5 completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a
6 restriction shall not authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C
7 commercial motor vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited
8 by law.

9 3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not
10 issue an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person
11 has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for
12 at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class
13 B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of
14 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a
15 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least
16 fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as
17 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B or C
18 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a restriction
19 for which a skills examination is required shall be required to
20 apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at
21 least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement.

22 4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service
23 Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid only
24 in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional

1 driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title, both of
2 which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they have
3 been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial motor
4 vehicle as provided in this subsection.

5 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as
6 provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit
7 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial
8 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal
9 period shall not be eligible for and Service Oklahoma shall not
10 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may
11 reapply for a new commercial learner permit, as provided for in this
12 subsection.

13 G. 1. For purposes of this title:

14 a. "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" or "Identification
15 Card" means a driver license or identification card
16 issued by the State of Oklahoma that has been
17 certified by the United States Department of Homeland
18 Security (USDHS) as compliant with the requirements of
19 the REAL ID Act of 2005, Public Law No. 109-13. A
20 REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification
21 Card and the process through which it is issued
22 incorporate a variety of security measures designed to
23 protect the integrity and trustworthiness of the
24 license or card. A REAL ID Compliant Driver License

1 or Identification Card will be clearly marked on the
2 face indicating that it is a compliant document, and
3 b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" or
4 "Identification Card" means a driver license or
5 identification card issued by the State of Oklahoma
6 that has not been certified by the United States
7 Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) as being
8 compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act. A
9 REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification
10 Card will be clearly marked on the face indicating
11 that it is not compliant with the federal REAL ID Act
12 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes.
13 The driver license or identification card will have a
14 unique design or color indicator that clearly
15 distinguishes it from a compliant license or card.

16 2. Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance:

- 17 a. Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL
18 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
19 shall be made to Service Oklahoma.
- 20 b. Service Oklahoma employees shall perform all document
21 recognition and other requirements needed for approval
22 of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID
23 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
24 application.

1 c. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL
2 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
3 application, the applicant may take the approved
4 application document to a licensed operator to receive
5 a temporary driver license or identification card.

6 d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL
7 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
8 Identification Card application and upon payment shall
9 provide the applicant a temporary driver license or
10 identification card. A temporary driver license or
11 identification card shall afford the holder the
12 privileges otherwise granted by the specific class of
13 driver license or identification card for the period
14 of time listed on the temporary driver license or
15 identification card or the period of time prior to the
16 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID
17 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card,
18 whichever time period is shorter.

19 3. REAL ID Compliant Driver License and Identification Card

20 Renewal and Replacement:

21 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID
22 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card may be
23 made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator;
24 provided, such licensed operator is authorized to

1 process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver
2 Licenses and Identification Cards. A licensed
3 operator may process the voluntary downgrade of a REAL
4 ID Compliant Commercial Driver License to any lower
5 class license upon request of the licensee; provided,
6 no additional endorsements or restrictions are placed
7 on the license.

8 b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed
9 operators shall perform all document recognition and
10 other requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
11 replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
12 Identification Card application.

13 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
14 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card
15 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
16 driver license or identification card from Service
17 Oklahoma or an authorized licensed operator.

18 d. A temporary driver license or identification card
19 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall
20 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by
21 the specific class of driver license or identification
22 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time
23 listed on the temporary driver license or
24 identification card or the period of time prior to the

1 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant Driver License
2 or Identification Card, whichever time period is
3 shorter.

- 4 e. For purposes of this title, an application for a REAL
5 ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card by
6 an individual with a valid Oklahoma-issued driver
7 license or identification card shall be considered a
8 renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
9 Identification Card.

10 4. REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License and Identification Card

11 Renewal and Replacement:

- 12 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID
13 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card may
14 be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator.
15 A licensed operator may process the voluntary
16 downgrade of a REAL ID Noncompliant Commercial Driver
17 License to any lower class license upon request of the
18 licensee; provided, no additional endorsements or
19 restrictions are added to the license.
- 20 b. Service Oklahoma employees or licensed operators shall
21 perform all document recognition and other
22 requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
23 replacement REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
24 Identification Card application.

1 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
2 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
3 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
4 driver license or identification card from Service
5 Oklahoma or a licensed operator.

6 d. A temporary driver license or identification card
7 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall
8 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by
9 the specific class of driver license or identification
10 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time
11 listed on the temporary driver license or
12 identification card or the period of time prior to the
13 applicant receiving a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver
14 License or Identification Card, whichever time period
15 is shorter.

16 H. 1. The fee charged for an approved application for an
17 original Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver
18 License or an approved application for the addition of an

5 B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration
6 date of an initial license shall be no more than either four (4)
7 years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of issuance
8 or no more than either four (4) years or eight (8) years from the
9 last day of the birth month of the applicant immediately preceding
10 the date of issuance, if requested by the applicant.

11 C. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration
12 date of a renewal license shall be:

13 1. For a renewal during the month of expiration, either four
14 (4) years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of
15 expiration of the expiring license or either four (4) or eight (8)
16 years from the last day of the birth month of the licensee
17 immediately preceding the expiration date of the expiring license,
18 if requested by the licensee; or

8 Oklahoma driver license.

9 E. Except as otherwise provided in this section, every driver
10 license shall be renewable by the licensee upon application to

12 current mailing address of the person and payment of the required

8 required to take an examination as specified by Service Oklahoma.

9 G. When a person makes application for a driver license, or
10 makes application to renew a driver license, and the person has been
11 convicted of, or received a deferred judgment for, any offense
12 required to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act,
13 the driver license shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from
14 the month of issuance, but may be renewed yearly during the time the
15 person is registered on the Sex Offender Registry. Notwithstanding
16 any other provision of law, the cost for such license shall be the
17 same as for other driver licenses and renewals.

18 H. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules prescribing forms of
19 identification acceptable for the renewal of an Oklahoma driver
20 license.

21 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-122, as
22 amended by Section 62, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
23 Section 6-122), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 6-122. Service Oklahoma may develop procedures whereby
2 driver licenses issued under the provisions of Section 6-101 et seq.
3 of this title may be renewed or replaced by the applicant by mail or
4 online except for licenses to be renewed ~~or replaced by aliens~~ by
5 applicants having previously provided proof of having filed a state
6 tax return and an individual tax identification number as prescribed
7 by subsection E of Section 6-115 of this title. Any license issued
8 pursuant to this section shall be valid for a period as prescribed
9 in Section 6-115 of this title. Service Oklahoma shall not renew or
10 replace a license by mail or online unless the immediately preceding
11 issuance, renewal or replacement was done in person by the
12 applicant.

13 Provided, any person or the spouse or dependent of a person:

14 1. Who is on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United
15 States; or

16 2. Who is currently employed as a civilian contractor with the
17 Armed Forces of the United States,
18 living outside of Oklahoma and having a valid Class D driver license
19 issued by the State of Oklahoma, requiring no material change, may
20 apply for no more than three consecutive renewals or replacement of
21 such license by mail or online, in accordance with Service Oklahoma
22 rules. A fourth consecutive renewal or replacement must be done in
23 person.

1 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Service Oklahoma shall make space available in the upper
5 left-hand corner of the front of a driver license issued to an
6 applicant that provided an individual tax identification number, for
7 the letters "N.R.", which shall be designed by Service Oklahoma and
8 shall serve as a notation of status as a non-resident of the United
9 States.

10 B. An applicant or licensee who provides an individual tax
11 identification number to Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator
12 shall be prohibited from receiving voter registration services as
13 described in subsection A of Section 4-109.3 of Title 26 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes.

15 SECTION 11. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
