

1 B. The school mapping data provided must:

2 1. Be compatible with software platforms used by local, county,
3 state, and federal public safety agencies that provide emergency
4 services to the specific school for which the data is provided
5 without requiring such agencies to purchase additional software or
6 requiring a fee to view or access the data;

7 2. Be compatible with security software platforms in use by the
8 specific school for which the data is provided without requiring the
9 local law enforcement agencies or school districts to purchase
10 additional software or requiring a fee to view or access the data;

11 3. Be in a printable format and, if requested in addition to
12 subsection A of this section, be in a digital file format that can
13 be integrated into interactive mobile platforms in use;

14 4. Be verified by the entity producing the data for accuracy by
15 a walk-through of school buildings and grounds;

16 5. Be oriented true north;

17 6. Be overlaid on current aerial imagery;

18 7. Contain site-specific labeling that matches the structure of
19 school buildings, including room labels, hallway names, and external
20 door or stairwell numbers and locations of hazards, critical utility
21 locations, key boxes, automated external defibrillators, and trauma
22 kits;

1 8. Contain site-specific labeling that matches the school
2 grounds, including parking areas, athletic fields, surrounding
3 roads, and neighboring properties; and

4 9. Be overlaid with gridded "x" and "y" coordinates.

5 C. School mapping data as defined by this section shall not be
6 modified or updated independently without corresponding updates to
7 school mapping data within software platforms used by local, county,
8 state, and federal public safety agencies that provide emergency
9 services to the specific school.

10 D. In order to facilitate efficient emergency response by
11 public safety agencies in the State of Oklahoma, the School District
12 Mapping Data Grant Program is created within the Oklahoma Department
13 of Public Safety. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety may
14 apply to receive funds to provide school mapping data for each
15 public school, including charter schools, in the district and each
16 private school. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety shall use
17 the funds to satisfy all or some of the requirements of this
18 section, which may include procuring a vendor to provide such data.
19 The entity producing the data is responsible for providing the data
20 to the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, school district, and
21 local law enforcement and public safety agencies for use in response
22 to emergencies and for conducting any required or authorized drills.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
