12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2.4F of Title 2, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Except as may otherwise be provided by law, the Oklahoma
17 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall be the state
18 entity empowered to implement all policy of the state regarding the
19 care, testing, and regulation of Chronic Wasting Disease and its
20 presence or lack thereof among cervidae in the state.

21 B. The Department shall, in consultation with no less than two
22 (2) out-of-state individuals or researchers reasonably considered by
23 the Department to be experts in the field of animal diseases,
24 promulgate rules as needed to implement the provisions of this act.

1 No county or other state agency or political subdivision of this
2 state shall enact or enforce any order, ordinance, or regulation, or
3 perform actions which conflict with, duplicate, or impede the
4 authority provided to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,
5 and Forestry pursuant to Section A of this act.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
