SENATE BILL 1925

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge designations; designating the Manuel "Pop" and Mary Ruth Russell Memorial Highway; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.431 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 70 beginning at Magnolia Street extending northeasterly to the intersection of Brody's Way and U.S. Highway 70 in Bryan County shall be designated as the "Manuel "Pop" and Mary Ruth Russell Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
