Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1010 allows state agencies to purchase equipment and supplies, not to exceed \$2,500, from a local business if they are located in a county without a contracted vendor. Agencies do not have to get approval from the State Purchasing Division for purchases, but are required to give the Central Purchasing Director a 72 hour notice before making the purchase. The measure requires agencies to maintain a file on each purchase, which is to include justifications for the purchase and any supporting documents.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1010 allows state agencies who are located in a county without a contracted vendor to make purchases not to exceed \$2,500 from local businesses. 72 hour notice must be given to the Central Purchasing Director prior to making the purchase. Per the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
