**Research Analysis**

Floor amendment 1 on HB 1036 provides that appointing authorities for the Veteran Suicide Prevention Task Force coordinate their appointments to reflect the best interests of veterans.

HB1036 creates the Veteran Suicide Prevention Task Force, a nine-person task force that will study and make recommendations regarding causes and prevention of suicide among Oklahoma veterans. Appointments will be made 60 days after the act's effective date and the appointing authorities must coordinate appointments to reflect the best interests of veterans. The task force will be set to sunset November 30, 2024, the date by which they must also submit a report of their findings and recommendations.
