**Research Analysis**

HB1379, as introduced, requires voter approval to create a tax increment financing (TIF) district. Current law only requires a majority vote of the governing body to approve a TIF district.

The measure also eliminates the ability for a TIF review committee to hold executive sessions and exceptions for withholding confidential information.
