**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 1445 requires school districts that have issued a bond proposal to post certain information on their website 30 days prior to the bond vote. The required information includes:

- Copy of the bond proposal, including each project to be funded;
- A description of each project; and
- The estimated cost for each project.

The school district must keep the information posted to the website for the duration of any approved bond, and for a year after completion. The district must update the information when there is a material change in the scope of the projects.
