**Research Analysis**

HB 1621 modifies the Forensic Review Board by removing certain listed requirements for membership on the Board. The measure modifies the definition of "reasonable period of time" as used to determine competence to stand trial to mean a period that starts on the first day of treatment and not to exceed 6 months for a misdemeanor offense and not longer than 1 year for a felony or the maximum period of the length of sentence.
