Research Analysis

HB 1734, as introduced, requires every dispensary or any place marijuana or THC products are sold to display signage at all times that reads, "WARNING: INGESTING THC PRODUCTS WHILE PREGNANT IS NOT HEALTHY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN UNBORN CHILD." The measure sets the minimum height and width requirements at eight and a half inches and eleven inches respectively. The signage will be produced at the expense of the owner.
