Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to **HB 1738** restore the title and clarify that such workers' compensation benefits apply to claims with an accident date on or after the effective date of the measure, January 1st, 2024.

HB 1738, as amended, updates the workers' compensation payment amounts for each child of a deceased worker to receive the following based on the total number of children:

- One child: \$25,000 and 15 percent of the worker's weekly wage
- Two to four children: \$25,000 and 30 percent of the worker's weekly wage
- Five or more children: \$100,000 and 30 percent of the worker's weekly wage
