HB1768 requires an individual registering to vote to provide a suitable document that shows the name and address of the voter such as a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1768 requires individuals without a valid Oklahoma driver license or identification card attempting to register to vote to provide an additional document verifying the individual's name and address. Per the State Election Board (SEB), this would require modifications to voter registration application forms and instructions. If this measure would be timed to coincide with the regular printing of new applications, it would have an estimated cost of less than \$1,500 to the agency.
