**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute to HB 1829 allows counties that participate in a multi-county library system to request an accounting of the library system's overall budget and estimate of need if approved by 2/3 vote of all participating boards of county commissioners. The executive director or the employee in charge of accounting is designated to produce the requested information. Additionally, the measure allows the board of county commissioners to decide on the location to present the budget and estimate of need findings.
