HB1929 increases the age limit to receive successful adulthood services from 21 to 25.

Fiscal Analysis

From the Department of Human Services:

This bill expands youth who are eligible to receive services under the Successful Adulthood program. It is estimated that the expansion would make an additional 800 youth eligible for funding. Approximately 50% or less access funding and the average amount per youth is just under \$1,000 per year.

$$800 \text{ youth} \times 50\% \text{ access to funding} \times \$1,000 \text{ per youth} = \$400,000$$

It is not known at this time if the additional workload will create a need for additional FTE.
