**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB2456 apportions 5% of unemployment insurance tax dollars into the UI trust fund to build a tech fund, and doubles the fee for failing to properly file contribution and wage reports from \$100 to \$200. Officials from the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission expect no appreciable budget impact from the rate shift. The conference committee substitute does not change the impact of the bill.
