**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2459 modifies personnel definitions according to the [Filmed in Oklahoma Act of 2021](#) and authorizes the Department of Commerce to approve an additional incentive of five percent of the qualified production expenditure amount for projects that filmed on location at least 25 percent of the time. The measure also requires projects that receive incentives to display a Department of Commerce-approved logo in the credits for at least two seconds.
