**Research Analysis**

HB 2464 creates the Independent Driver Classification Act. The measure provides that all Transportation Network Company (TNC) drivers are to be considered independent contractors and not employees of the TNC if the TNC does not prescribe specific hours during which the driver is to be logged into the TNC's digital network, the TNC imposes no restrictions on the driver's ability to use digital networks from other TNC's; the TNC does not restrict the driver from engaging in any other occupation; and the TNC and driver agree in writing that the driver is an independent contractor.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2464 specifies that all Transportation Network Company (TNC) drivers are to be considered independent contractors if the TNC does not prescribe them specific hours the driver is to be logged into the TNC digital network. This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
