Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB 2631, allows for wine and spirits wholesalers to ship orders non-sequentially, and to fill orders non-sequentially but only on products that have been designated as being in short supply.

The measure defines short supply, and requires the ABLE Commission to publish a list of every product designated by the Director to be in short supply on their website every thirty days.

The measure also requires the wholesaler to also send an updated notice to the ABLE Commission if the product is in short supply. If no notice is received, the ABLE Commission is required to remove the product.

Fiscal Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB2631 authorizes wine and spirits wholesalers to fill orders non-sequentially only on products that have been designated as being in short supply. The measure also mandates that the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission publish a list of every product designated as short supply. This measure is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations.
