Research Analysis

HB 2647 expands the scope of the declaration that firearms and ammunition are not to be considered a nuisance to include firearm accessories. The measure provides definitions for ammunition, dealer, exporter, firearm, firearm accessory, importer, manufacturer, person, and trade association. The measure prohibits a person from bringing a civil action against a firearm, firearm accessory, or ammunition manufacturer, distributor, dealer, importer, exporter, or trade association, or the owners, shareholders, directors, and employees of any such entity, for certain actions.
