Research Analysis

HB 2722, as introduced, requires that any state entity that has contact with someone that could utilize provisions of the Oklahoma Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Act, have information readily accessible in the form of a brochure or other publication or by making the information about the program available on the agency website. The measure lists the specific state agencies that the requirement applies to, and directs all entities that enter into contract with the government make information available using the same or similar methods.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2722 requires any governmental entity within the executive branch of the state government of Oklahoma to have information readily accessible about the Oklahoma ABLE act and the benefits it may provide in the form of a brochure or other publication or by making the information available on the agency website. This measure's allowance for online publications should allow agencies to implement the provisions of the measure without a need for additional revenues.
