**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2862 authorizes the State Department of Agriculture to implement all policy regarding Chronic Wasting Disease. The Department's policies shall supersede the policies of any other state agency, political subdivision, or county. The Department is required to consult with at least two out-of-state experts to promulgate rules regarding the disease.
