**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure modifies provisions regarding the scope and scale of trespassing, as well as provides certain requirements for notices and waiting periods before entry is allowed to perform services, surveys, and examinations on protected properties. The potential costs of enforcing the provisions related to this legislation are likely to be negligible, and any duties related to such enforcement would fall within an involved agency's normal operations. In its current form, HB2964 might create a small change to the amount of fines and fees collected per the related statutes, but this is not expected to have a negative impact on state budget or appropriations.
