Research Analysis

HB 3786 extends the period of exemption for retired peace officers from the application requirements to become licensed as an armed security guard or armed private investigator from 1 year to 5 years after retirement as a peace officer. The measure also exempts a retired peace officer from the requirement to submit a fingerprint card to CLEET and from the requirement of submitting copy of any existent criminal history data if the applicant submits a notarized letter confirming that the peace officer retired in good standing when making an application to become an armed security guard or armed private investigator.
