**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to House Bill 3797 adds "Oklahoma's Protection and Advocacy System" to the list of definitions used in the Protective Services for Vulnerable Adults Act and requires the Department of Human Services to forward a copy of all initial reports and findings to Oklahoma's Protection and Advocacy System. The measure also requires all initial written reports of incidents or situations to be mailed to the Department and Oklahoma's Protection and Advocacy System within five working days after the incident or situation.

**Fiscal Analysis**
