**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB1176 modifies the incentive criteria for any investment rebate authorized pursuant to the Large-scale Economic Activity and Development Act of 2022 (LEAD Act). The measure lower the new job requirement from 4000 to 3500 by year 4 and 5 of the rebate period. The measure also provides for the transfer of unencumbered fund in the LEAD fund to the General Revenue Fund if the Oklahoma Department of Commerce does not have a binding investment commitment from a qualified company by April 15, 2023.

SB 1176 in its current form modifies employment thresholds in the LEAD Act; as well as, provided for the transfer of approximately \$698 Million upon a certain contingency.
