SB 1736 excludes the State Council for Interstate Juvenile Supervision from the definition of public body as found in the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

Excludes the Statewide Independent Living Council from the definition of public body as found in the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

The floor substitute to SB 1736 expands the "public body" definition to exclude the State Council for Interstate Juvenile Supervision as well as the Statewide Independent Living Council as it relates to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
