Research Analysis

SB 1768 allows school districts to provide instruction virtually on days with inclement weather, lack of teachers due to illness, and building maintenance issues. The measure requires the district to meet certain requirements when providing a virtual instruction day and subjects them to possible audit by the State Department of Education for verification. Further, a district administrator must notify the State Department of Education within 72 hours of choosing to provide school virtually. The SDE must determine whether the school's decision to do so complied with the requirements, and if not, the school must provide students with a make-up day.
