**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for SB 375 specifies that a primary election will be held on the third Tuesday in June of each even-numbered year. This is also one of the dates in which a political subdivision is authorized to call elections. Declarations of Candidacy must be filed no earlier than 8am on the first Wednesday of April of any even-numbered year and no later than 5pm on the next succeeding Friday.
