Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 806 requires that applicants for a medical marijuana business license provide proof of possessory right to the real estate where the business will operate by submitting a copy of an executed deed of conveyance or a signed lease for the property.

The measure prohibits the transfer of a license or goods beyond the normal scope of business without the permission of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority. Any entity seeking to transfer the license must apply to the Authority for permission. The application fee for the application to transfer will be the same as the fee charged for the underlying license application.

The measure also restricts any address or physical location from having multiple licenses of the same type except for a commercial grower with a combination of indoor and outdoor growing facilities.
