Bill Analysis

HB 1028 prohibits the hitting, slapping, paddling, or any other means of inflicting physical pain on a student identified with a disability who is on an individualized education program. It removes language allowing a parent or legal guardian to provide written consent to administer corporal punishment on a student with the most significant cognitive disabilities.
