Bill Analysis

HB 2459 requires apprentices as they relate to the Filmed in Oklahoma Act of 2021 to complete safety training appropriate for the duties to be performed in connection with a qualified project and also to complete a course related to and with the objective of preventing workplace misbehavior. The measure extends the credit to include the salaries and benefits of employees who are enrolled as full-time students at a college or university located in the state offering an undergraduate degree program or who are on active military duty and stationed in Oklahoma or involved in a restorative workforce program. The measure expands the credit provided in the Act to include 2% of the qualified production expenditure amount for the post-production expenses relating to music. The base amount of credit is increased from 20% to 30% of the qualifying costs of the project.
