Bill Analysis

HB 2631 authorizes every wine and spirits wholesaler to ship orders to retailers non-sequentially and fill orders non-sequentially only on products that have been designated as being in short supply. Short supply is defined as those individual brand labels of alcoholic beverages normally supplied by the manufacturer or manufacturers that, for whatever reason, lack sufficient supply to fully satisfy the demand of the Oklahoma retail and/or on-premises market. The measure directs manufacturers to notify wholesalers and the ABLE Commission in the event of short supply. The ABLE Commission shall publish a list of every product designated as short supply by the Director on its website every 30 days.
