Bill Analysis

SB 1112 modifies set back requirements for polling places. The measure provides that no person engaged in electioneering may be within 300 feet of the entrance of a polling place or person standing in line to vote rather than the ballot box. Electioneering is defined as advocating directly for or against a candidate or question that is or will be on the ballot at any election as well as gathering signatures for a petition to place an issue or question on a future ballot or soliciting contact information or distributing information for any candidate or issue that might be on a future ballot.
