Bill Analysis

SB 1666 prohibits the Governor from closing or forcing a business to close without documented scientific evidence that the nature of a particular business actually contributes to the direct spreading of disease relating to the pandemic. The Governor must give notice and hearing to any business determined to be nonessential or detrimental to the health and safety of citizens during a pandemic before issuing an executive order against keeping such business open.
