**Bill Analysis**

SB 345 prohibits any person under the age of 21 from undergoing gender reassignment medical treatment. Additionally, no parent or guardian may obtain gender reassignment medical treatment for child under the age of 18 in his or her care. No health care professional may intentionally perform gender reassignment medical treatment on a person who is under the age of 21. Any person found to have violated the provisions of this measure may face a term of imprisonment no less than 3 years and no more than life imprisonment and/or a maximum fine of \$20,000.00.
