Bill Analysis

SB 700 modifies the Declarations of Candidacy by requiring the candidate to note the date the candidate registered as a voter of the political party as well as his or her voter identification number. The measure also provides that spoiled ballots shall be placed in a separate receptacle and returned to the county election board. The measure modifies “absentee ballot harvesting” by requiring the person to knowingly commit the act. The measure provides that complaints of voter fraud may be submitted to the county election board.
