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**Bill Analysis**

SB 931 expands the practice of pharmacy to include ordering, performing, and interpreting tests authorized by the Food and Drug Administration and waived under the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 as well as the initiation of drug therapy for minor, nonchronic health conditions. Minor, nonchronic health conditions are defined by the measure as a typically short-term health condition that is generally managed with noncontrolled drug therapies, minimal treatment, or self-care such as the flu. The measure also expands the practice to include the dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives and any nicotine replacement therapy product that is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration. Pharmacists may utilize such procedures starting January 1, 2024.

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
