Bill Analysis

SB 95 prohibits a public school district, public charter school, or employees thereof from providing sexually explicit material to a student enrolled in the school without written consent from the student's parent or legal guardian. The measure states that if a student is provided a book or other written medium with sexually explicit material for which consent was not provided, the parent or legal guardian has a cause of action against the district or charter school.
